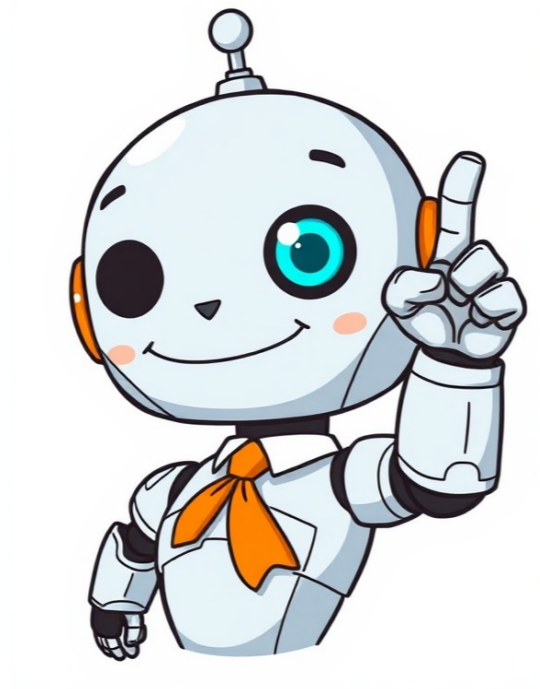

There are more MDs than DOs in the United States, with almost 9 in 10 doctors having an MD degree. However, interest in DO programs is rising, with enrollment increasing by 68% between 2011-2012 and 2021-2022. DOs also learn about osteopathic manipulative medicine, which focuses on relieving back pain, neck pain, strained muscles, and other conditions using physical manipulations and adjustments. In terms of approach, MDs tend to focus on diagnosing specific symptoms, while DOs take a more holistic view, considering how different parts of the body work together. If you're choosing between an MD and a DO, consider their approach, location, specialty, and health conditions they treat. Patient satisfaction also tends to be higher for osteopathic doctors compared to other types of healthcare providers. Ultimately, both MDs and DOs are well-trained doctors who use technology and provide quality care. The distinction between MDs and DOs lies in their training and approach to medicine. MDs typically focus on treating individual organs or systems, whereas DOs consider how all the body's systems work together. Both types of doctors can specialize in surgery, with most surgeons holding an MD degree.
