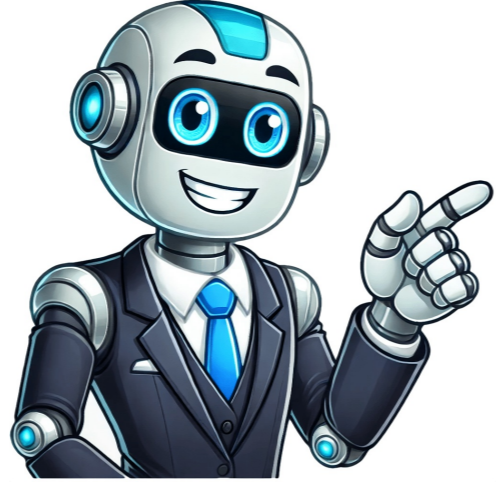

NY Bar examiners failed to provide results online as scheduled at midnight, leaving candidates frustrated and anxious. Several users reported difficulties logging in, with some speculating the examiners' mistake might be due to inadequate system preparation. The NY Bar Examiners' handling of the situation has been criticized, with many expressing anger and disappointment on Reddit threads. Some users were able to access their results despite not having completed an L.M. program, while others were met with an unhelpful registration option for July's exam. A few Redditors have questioned the NY Bar Examiners' decision to provide a button asking users to sign up for July's exam, which some interpreted as a way of telling them they failed. The situation has raised concerns about the NYBOLE's management and customer service, with many calling for immediate action. To address complaints about the IT support and make improvements, there is a reduced number of experts to rely on if the in-house team gets caught off guard. This can lead to lengthy wait times for applicants as they try to find a solution. While initial results may appear available now, it's essential to remember that this experience should be reported to BOLE, so they can understand how to improve everyone's life and provide better support at reasonable hours. A simple reform is required, but it needs the input of users to make significant changes. The board has been in operation since 1894 and oversees the administration of the exam twice a year, with 16,574 applications received in 2024. A recent update informed applicants about the adoption of the NextGen Bar Examination, which will be implemented starting from July 2028. ### The New York State Bar Examination Administration Has Made Several Changes The February administration of the bar examination has new requirements. The Board is trying to reduce the number of applicants for each test site by changing the date in which the applications are filed. Applicants can now file between October 1 and October 31, instead of March 1 to March 31. The July administration of the New York State Bar Examination will no longer accept late applications from people who did not take the February exam. However, applicants who failed the February exam will be able to reapply for the July exam within seven days of the results release date. For the February exam, the July 29-30, 2025 UBE in New York will be administered in-person with no remote option available. The test will consist of paper question booklets, and applicants must answer MBE questions on a provided paper scantron answer sheet. For those who selected the laptop option for the MPT and MEE, an email from ExamSoft will be sent May 5, 2025, with instructions to purchase, download, and register Examplify software. Applicants must complete registration with ExamSoft by May 22, 2025, at 4:30 PM ET, as failure to do so will result in being removed from the laptop program and switching to handwriting the exam. It is recommended not to wait until the last minute for mandatory registration steps. Test center assignments will be based on availability and first-come, first-served basis. Applicants will receive an email during June 2nd containing a link to select their preferred location. First-time applicants from New York State law schools will have priority in selecting their location. The Board does not maintain a wait list for locations. All applicants must make a test site selection, as failing to do so may result in being withdrawn from the examination. To withdraw from the July 2025 bar exam, log into your BOLE Account and click on the Withdrawal from Examination button. Application Fee Policy and Bar Examination Updates The application fee for the New York State Bar Examination is non-refundable, but applicants with extenuating circumstances may request a one-time credit of the fee by submitting a written request that includes their BOLE Number, reason for withdrawal, and supporting documentation. Candidates who have withdrawn from or failed to appear for three or more examinations may need to petition the Board before re-applying for a future examination. The deadline for candidates to apply for the July 2025 New York State Bar Examination is April 29, 2025, at 11:59 PM ET. The February 2025 New York State Bar Examination results were posted on April 22, 2025. A list of passing candidates will be available on April 23, 2025. Candidates who failed the examination can re-apply for the July 2025 examination by submitting their application and required documentation by the deadline. The New York Law Examination (NYLE) is scheduled to take place on September 18, 2025. The deadline to complete the New York Law Course and register for the NYLE is August 19, 2025. Applicants must also purchase and download the Examsoft software and register with the Board by the deadline. Candidates who have previously withdrawn or failed to appear for previous examinations may need to petition the Board before re-applying for a subsequent bar examination if the Board determines that they do not make a bona fide effort to pass the examination.
