While specific views and beliefs about the sun vary greatly among the native tribes in North America, there are some communities. For example, the sun is often a healer, peace-loving, and an object that radiates light from a powerful entity on the world. As with cultures around the world, many indigenous peoples in North America see the sun as a facilitator of cultivation and representative of growth. In addition, the sunset is respected: It makes way for the moon, which is commonly seen as a guide, protector and timekeeper, among other things. In some Western European cultures, sunsets may represent closing the door on a particular stage of life for something new or even the end of life.
