Common neurological conditions treated include Alzheimer's disease, migraines, neuropathic pain, Parkinson's disease, stroke, epilepsy, multiple sclerosis, brain tumors, spinal cord tumors, and more. The practice offers a range of diagnostic tests and therapeutic procedures, such as Botox injections, electromyography, autonomic testing, electroencephalography, and trigger point injections. Colonial Family Practice provides primary care services, including same-day appointments, on-site diagnostic testing, and urgent care with extended hours. For your first visit, please bring any relevant test results or medication information. You can also pre-register online or use the patient portal to update forms. Colonial Pediatrics provides well-child care, preventive medicine, and immunization schedules in line with American Academy of Pediatrics and Centers for Disease Control guidelines. Children should receive a pediatrician visit at 2 weeks, 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, and 24 months after birth. Children aged 2 and above are seen every 12 months. Additionally, physical exams are conducted for sports, school, and summer camp participation. If a medical issue arises, Colonial Family Practice is recommended as the primary contact. With over a dozen primary care providers, same-day appointments are available for most illnesses or injuries. The clinic also offers on-site diagnostic testing and urgent care services (with extended hours, 7 days a week) in both Sumter and Manning locations. Physician assistants are medical professionals who have completed an accredited education program and are licensed to practice within their state's guidelines. They are trained to perform routine tasks that physicians can do, such as taking medical histories, conducting physical exams, ordering lab tests, and administering inoculations. In some states, they may also prescribe medications, but most often work under the supervision of a physician. Nurse practitioners, on the other hand, are registered nurses with graduate degrees in nursing who are prepared for advanced practice. They can make independent and interdependent decisions and are accountable for their clinical judgments. The tasks they perform vary based on geographic, political, economic, and social factors, and may include providing primary health care services. There are various specialties within the nurse practitioner field, including family, gerontological, pediatric, obstetric-gynecologic, and school nurse practitioners. Colonial Healthcare has a friendly staff that welcomes patients and is available to answer questions about their medical services. Patients can schedule appointments by calling the main office or using the secure online appointment request form. The practice has several locations, including Colonial Urgent Care, Colonial Family Practice - Liberty, Colonial Family Practice, Colonial Pediatrics, Colonial Neurology, Colonial Sports Medicine Joint & Arthritis Clinic, and Colonial Family Practice - Wesmark, each with its own hours of operation. Santee Cooper Urgent Care shares the same address but operates from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm weekdays and from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturdays and Sundays. Santee Cooper Primary Care also has its own schedule at this location, open from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday and the same hours for Saturday and Sunday. Colonial Family Practice in Columbia can be reached at (803) 256-1511 between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm on weekdays except Fridays when it closes at 12:00 pm.
