QuickBooks is an accounting software developed by Intuit for small and medium-sized businesses, first introduced in 1992. Initially released as a DOS version based on Quicken codebase, QuickBooks later evolved into separate Windows and Mac versions with different codebases. The software gained immense popularity among small business owners lacking formal accounting training, capturing up to 85% of the US market share. However, professional accountants criticized early versions for poor security controls and non-conformity with traditional accounting standards. Intuit addressed these concerns by providing full audit trail capabilities, double-entry accounting functions, and increased features. By 2000, Basic and Pro versions were developed, followed by industry-specific versions in 2003. These offerings catered to various business types, including manufacturers, wholesalers, professional service firms, contractors, non-profit entities, and retailers. In May 2002, QuickBooks Enterprise Solutions was launched for medium-sized businesses. By 2008, QuickBooks dominated the US retail unit market share with 94.2%. The company also boasts over 50,000 members in its ProAdvisor program, comprising accountants, CPAs, and independent business consultants. Recent releases, such as QuickBooks 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020, have introduced features like improved income tracking, automated reports, mobile inventory barcode scanning, and payroll adjustment capabilities. These updates aim to enhance user experience and reliability. With ongoing development and improvement, QuickBooks remains a leading accounting software solution for small and medium-sized businesses. QuickBooks offers various features to cater to customers' needs, including automatic payment reminders, collapse and expand columns, easy QuickBooks version update, and more. On September 4, 2020, Intuit released QuickBooks 2021 with improved payment processes and automated features. This version includes streamlined bank feeds, automated receipt management, rule-based customer groups, payment reminders, customized payment receipts, data level permissions, and batch delete sales orders. QuickBooks versions are available in multiple markets, with divisions like Canada, UK, Australia offering region-specific tax calculations. The QuickBooks UK edition also supports Irish and South African VAT. However, the company has withdrawn its Point of Sale software from sale on October 3, 2023, citing platform complexity. Intuit's cloud service, QuickBooks Online, allows users to access the software through a secure logon via a Web browser, with optional monthly subscription fees. As of May 2014, it had over 624,000 subscribers. The cloud version has many features that differ from its desktop counterpart and is available in various regions. QuickBooks Point of Sale software tracks inventory, sales, and customer information, providing reports for business management. In early 2023, Intuit announced the discontinuation of this software on October 3, 2023.
